Re: California Proposition 65

Specialty Minerals, Inc., affirms that our products meet the requirements of safety per California Proposition 65 regulations for the presence of levels of the carcinogenic substances. The products contain small but detectable impurity amounts of Lead (< 3 ppm), which is a listed substance in the California Safety Drinking Water and Toxic Enforcement Act.

We further affirm that organic substances listed as Prop 65 concerns will not be present in our minerals above limits set by the legislation. SMI does not employ organic substances in the manufacture of our mineral products. Examples of Prop 65 listed include, but are not limited to: Dioxanes, PCBs, chlorinated aliphatic organics, furans, glycols, ketones, and aldehydes, alcohols of any kind, amino compounds, or pesticide residues.

We do not routinely test for these substances as they are not naturally occurring in our minerals or used in production. Historical testing has not identified the presence of these substances.
